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PLEASE CALL OUR OFFICE IN ADVANCE IF YOU HAVE ANY CHANGES IN YOUR HEALTH ANYTIME PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED PROCEDURE.

- 1. CANCELLATION POLICY: Appointments must be confirmed at least 48 hours before your appointment date and time. Any appointments NOT CONFIRMED WITHIN 48 HOURS WILL BE CANCELLED.**
- 2. NOTHING TO EAT, NOTHING TO DRINK, 8 HOURS BEFORE your procedure, including water.**
- 3. REFRAIN FROM THE USE OF RECREATIONAL DRUGS 3 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR SURGERY.** This includes **ANY Form of Marijuana** (smoking, tinctures, vaping, dabbing, oils, CBD, edibles, etc.) and alcohol.
- 4. TAKE ALL PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS IN YOUR USUAL MANNER WITH JUST ENOUGH WATER TO SWALLOW THEM,** unless your physician or oral surgeon instruct you to do otherwise.
- 5. Wear a loose, short sleeved top, & close-toe shoes. **NO ACRYLIC, LONG NAILS, DARK/SPARKLY NAIL POLISH.****
- 6. **DO NOT PLAN TO DRIVE UNTIL 24 HOURS AFTER YOUR SURGERY.** YOU SHOULD NOT DRIVE IF YOU ARE TAKING PRESCRIPTION PAIN MEDICATION.**
- 7. **YOU CAN NOT BE DROPPED OFF.**** Arrange to have someone bring you to our office and **STAY HERE** with us during your **ENTIRE** appointment. Otherwise, your appointment may be rescheduled.

Failure to adhere to these instructions may result in your surgery being rescheduled
